The venue:

The venue is fully accessible, with lifts to different floors in the accommodation and a stair lift in the meeting area. Dietary needs are catered for and meals are clearly labelled on the menu. All meeting rooms are well ventilated with high ceilings.

There is some fully accessible bedroom accommodation with walk in showers without a step. Others have a shower cubicle. Standard rooms are ensuite and either twin, double or single occupancy. In addition, this year we have some shared budget accommodation in the College's Fire station. Full details below.

The site is level with plenty of parking. We are advised that for people travelling by public transport to Moreton in Marsh, it's best to book a taxi to reach the campus. There are no camping/caravanning facilities.

We have use of the Sports Centre and swimming pool during our stay. Just saying.

Booking:

Standard tickets for the weekend include

- accommodation on Friday and Saturday nights,
- all meals
- and cover the costs associated with guests and venue.

They are

£270.00 each (where two people are sharing a twin/double room)

£390.00 each for a single occupancy room.

There is an option to extend the ticket for a third night and programmed events run till the end of the afternoon, with a survivors' session marked for the evening. Further details are on the booking form.

New this year:

As well as the standard ticket price this year there is an option to pay a bit more/pay a bit less, depending on your circumstances. Further details on the booking form.

Budget accommodation - hostel style. The college has offered us use of their fire station this time, which accommodates 16 in three 4 bed and 2 twin bed rooms (no bunks). Bathroom facilities are shared. **I will not be choosing your room mates.** You may need earplugs and sleep masks. I have reserved 8 places (two rooms) for Youth tickets. After that, it will be first come, first served and a waiting list, in the event that the Youth tickets aren't taken up. **If this option interests you, email to make sure there is still a place available.**

Please make sure to complete all sections of the booking form, particularly the section regarding special requirements. If you want a room next to friends, make a note of that as well. If you want to share a room, make a note of who you want to share it with!

Other developments:

If you'd love to come but have some doubts about transport, then let us know and we'll see if there's any way to organise a lift-share.

I will check with local taxi firms again to see which of them are available to collect folks from the train station.
